We make change in three interconnected ways: building newcomer social connections, supporting newcomer integration priorities, and amplifying community involvement in newcomer integration.

THE WELCOME GROUP PROGRAM

Together Project's core program matches refugee newcomers with "Welcome Groups" of typically 3-5 volunteers. Welcome Groups provide social support to newly-arrived refugees that focuses on their unique integration priorities, such as language learning, finding employment, accessing health care, and building social connections.

Together Project provides a platform for community engagement to address these challenges, ensuring that it both complements the work of existing service providers and is tailored to the needs of individual newcomers.

We only ask volunteers to give the gift of their time; no financial commitment is required. Volunteers receive training to work safely and effectively with newcomer refugees.

OUR IMPACT

SOCIAL CONNECTIONS

Getting settled in a new place is easier when you are connected to members of your new community, and this kind of social capital can be hard to come by for refugee newcomers. We connect newcomers to volunteers who can provide social support and expand their social networks.

Connected communities are happier, healthier, and more resilient. Social connections can also play an important role in newcomer health and well-being.

INTEGRATION

Every newcomer family is different and faces unique challenges in integrating in their new community. Together Project uses a matching system that connects volunteers and newcomers based on shared preferences, interests, and skill sets.

The newcomer-defined integration priorities give the match a shared purpose as the newcomers and volunteers work on addressing these priorities together.

COMMUNITY

We work with local partners to ensure that volunteers complement existing settlement services and have a meaningful role in supporting newcomer integration. Volunteers receive guidance and access to resources throughout their match.

The Welcome Group Program is an opportunity for community members to take part in the "twoway street" of integration, and a way to promote positive discourse and experiences around newcomer integration.
